The annual Parish Council meeting took place at the Village Hall on 9 May and as I indicated in the May edition of Findon News, the Council was able to appoint the Chairman and Deputy Chairman for the coming year. I will be continuing in my role as Chairman and my deputy will be Cllr Linda Martin. Linda is also taking over the lead councillor role for the Allotment Gardens from Cllr Robin Carr and there will be a handover period with Robin.

I think it is an opportune time for me to thank Robin for all his help and support in the last few years as my deputy. His knowledge of the village has been and continues to be invaluable.

You may have already seen the posters on the notice boards regarding Arun Community Transport services. The organisation is run by volunteers offering to drive people who find it difficult to access public transport, or where public transport is not available, for appointments such as doctors, hospitals and dentists. The service is also available for trips providing social inclusion, such as clubs, shopping and visiting. To register or make a booking, please ring 01903 792110 (office hours 9am to 1pm).

West Sussex County Council (WSCC) has recently provided the Council with a number of very useful items of

emergency equipment as part of its Community Resilience programme. Items include foil survival blankets, Road Closed signs and high intensity lamps. In a future newsletter we will be seeking interest for involvement in our resilience team.

The WSCC scheme to build a 2km cycleway/walkway route has been approved This will connect Findon Valley with the South Downs National Park gateway of Findon Village. The works are expected to commence in the autumn. Further details can be found on the website of WSCC under Highways, Transport & Planning. The works form part of the County Council's Active Travel improvement proposals.

With the Platinum Jubilee due to take place in early June, I am sure you will join with the Parish Council in sending congratulations to Her Majesty on such a wonderful achievement. The majority of us will only ever have known the Elizabethan era. As in all things, Her Majesty has seen many changes in her lifetime, but she has been there as a steadying influence over us all.

News from Paws Animal Sanctuary

We keep all our animal food in metal bins to make sure it is kept fresh and no mice or rats can get at it. Poultry feeders are hung up on hooks in the runs suspended to keep the food off the ground image our horror when two rats were seen coming from the farmers field next to our hen house. We bought four humane rat traps and and have tried all sorts of bait to try and catch them, we caught one and he squeaked and squeaked and must have warned all the others one of our volunteers took him up to the middle of the woods to release him. We have since seen others so every night we tried Kit Kats and cheese. Then someone suggested peanut butter would work. We are on our second jar of peanut butter and still not caught any more rats. But, one morning there was a little black cat in one of the traps I quickly let it out and it was off like a shot. Another morning there was a bird

in one of the traps and tonight I had only just put the traps down and a blackbird went straight in to one. Our resident cat prefers to stay out at night in the warm weather so we are hoping she will scare the rats off.

Three pretty grey and white pet mice were brought in from an owner who is pregnant and was told by her doctor they spread diseases. We put them in a large glass tank with lots of tunnels and a wheel and they are so entertaining. We have Degus, Gerbils and Hamsters but none have the energy these little mice have, luckily they are all girls (we don't need any more). When we were young all the pet shops sold white mice, but you never see them for sale any more, these are the first pet mice we have ever had.

One of the biggest headaches is trying to cut the dogs nails, the grooming parlour and our Vets don't like doing it and all of our dogs hate having their nails cut. I have just discovered that you can now buy a hammock with four holes for the dogs' legs to go in that can be suspended from the ceiling, the dog's weight prevents them from biting you when you are cutting their nails. Hopefully this invention will work, there are many to choose from on line so I will definitely be investing in one. The Pony is hardly limping now after the plate was put in his shoulder, it has taken a long time for him to get better and the operation was expensive, he also has Yumove every night and laser acupuncture weekly. He and the donkey have their feet trimmed every eight weeks, and now they both need the horse dentist!!

The sunflower cards are all sold and I am currently painting a "Colours of Ukraine" card with a mixture of blue and yellow flowers. These will be on sale in June in the same venues and I hope you will like them.

I have had this message from the charity.

"Thanks to your donation we can provide medical and humanitarian aid for the wounded, stranded and displaced people in Ukraine, and it will help save their lives.

This is a quick update on what we have achieved in the last few weeks so far:

1) we sent 11 lorries, 11 ambulances, 8 cars, 13 vans and 1 plane loaded with medical and humanitarian aid to Ukraine;

2) with the help of volunteers from Plast London and Support Ukraine, we assembled and sent 5,000 First Aid Kits;


3) we procured and delivered 11 ambulances to Ukraine;
