Purpose of report Update

1 Letter sent to Deborah Urquart at West Sussex County Council re

- **Reducing the speed limit on Nepcote Lane to Cissbury Ring**
DU advised that we would require a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO) to change the speed limit. DU advised that although this was not successful in the past, it might be more successful now with the increased emphasis on walking and cycling. Working group to put together information required to apply for TRO.
- **Making School Hill one way**
DU advised that we would require the view of all villagers re changing School Hill to one way and felt that one way up would be better received by Highways because northbound access to the A24 from the High Street by the Black Horse was considered dangerous. First step would be a survey of villagers on School Hill potentially organised by a resident? The second step would be a survey of all villagers – perhaps in Findon News?

2 Contact made with Stagecoach re moving bus stop

- Contact made with Stagecoach re the possibility of moving the bus stop on the High Street from outside the Gun to reduce congestion at the centre of the village – awaiting response - to be recontacted.

3 Village Hall Parking

- Sean Smith to update on meeting with St John Baptist Primary School re using the Village Hall car park for school drop off and pick up.

4 EV Charging Points

- On-street EV charging points have been approved in Lime Road, Findon Village BN14 0UL and Findon Road, Findon Valley BN14 0DW. Installation to take place summer or early autumn 2025.

5 Further actions

- Update on contact with Strava re speed challenge from Cissbury Ring to Gun
- Open spaces group – following discussion, it was agreed that all signage was fine and did not require assistance from OSG
- Further action re resurfacing car park at Pond Green tbc.
- Further action re repainting road markings at the top of Horsham Road.
