Following a presentation, the following Q&A session took place: AiRS is funded by DEFRA and local councils Rural Exception Sites (RES) could be gifted or sold at a discount by a landowner (typically £10k per plot) and can be restricted to local people; Landowners could also identify a suitable small parcel of land e.g. land at an edge of a field; RES have to be well connected to a settlement (roads, footpaths, services; Housing Associations (HA) could get funding from government subject to a viability study; AiRS has a list of additional funding streams and templates on its website www.ruralsussex.org.uk; Parishes could consider clustering for areas of interest;
