CURRENT PROJECTS

- 1 Reduce speed limit on Cissbury Ring Road**
 - TRO application to reduce the speed limit on Cissbury Ring Road has been started – aiming to complete by end February 2026.
 - Signs for road being sourced - Cyclists Please Slow Down / Take Care Slow Down Hidden Entrance - Budget £30-100.
 - Cllr Kenna to liaise with Men In Sheds re signage to ensure the correct signs are purchased.

- 2 Making School Hill One way**
 - Community TRO application to make School Hill one-way has been started following the overall positive response to the village survey.
 - Cllr Dean liaising with WSCC with regards to signage to reduce the size of vehicles using School Hill.
 - Council looking into the ownership of the verges on School Hill with a view to cutting them back to give greater visibility.

- 3 Bus stop on the High Street**
 - WSCC Highways team has suggested that the council applies for a TRO to put double yellow lines next Greypoint House.
 - Photographs and measurements for the double yellow lines required for the TRO application have been taken.
 - TRO application has been started – it is hoped that the double yellow lines will negate the requirement to move the north bound bus stop – aiming to complete by end January 2026.

- 4 Resurface car park at Pond Green**
 - Cllr Kelly Dean exploring costs / grants and onward planning to resurface the car park at Pond Green.
