	PQT started at 7.33pm Geoffrey Wyatt, the applicant, spoke in support of application SDNP/18/05896/FUL and provided background on the history of the site and the current proposals. Rebecca Hill spoke in support of the application regarding the change of use and provided details of her professional background in the equine industry. For clarification, the riding school would be for non-professional riders, provide a safe environment for younger riders, and offer employment for five people in the yard. It was also hoped to run college/Pony Club courses and riding holiday breaks, thus providing tourism benefits for the village. In response to a question, overflow car parking was already available at Cissbury. PQT closed at 7.38pm.
