Title of Report Clerk's report on items not covered elsewhere on the Agenda

Purpose of Report To note/action/ratify

1. Updates for noting/action

1.1 Governance documentation such as Standing Orders, Financial Regulations and Committee Terms of Reference are due for review and early on in the new Parish Council year would be an appropriate time for this to take place. In addition, I will be developing a bespoke Document Retention Policy for the Council. This process will take place over the summer and reported at a future Finance & Governance Committee meeting prior to adoption by Findon Parish Council (FPC).

2. Issues for consideration/ratification by full Council

- 2.1 Councillors are asked to consider/ratify the following items:
- 2.2 Arrangements and guidance for Parish Member appointments to the South Downs National Park Authority (SDNPA) 2019 has been received from the Sussex Assoc of Local Councils (as circulated). As the Nomination Forms will be posted out to FPC on Monday 13 May 2019 for completion and return to the SDNPA by Friday 24 May, consideration for any nomination must take place at the FPC meeting on 13 May 2019.
- 2.3 An offer to accommodate any new village defibrillator has been received from a resident adjacent to Nepcote Green who is happy to have it installed on his wall and has connection to an electrical supply. Does FPC wish to either consider the purchase of an additional defibrillator for Findon or explore external grant funding for the equipment.
- 2.4 St John the Baptist School is holding the Annual Summer Revels on Saturday 18 May 2019 which includes a short time on Pond Green. Councillors have been circulated with the Risk Assessment and insurance documentation from the School PTA, and formal ratification of the agreement to use Pond Green is now sought.
- 2.5 I have received details of a Duke of Edinburgh Adventure event taking place between 20-22 September 2019 with overnight camping at the Gallops Farm (as previously circulated). In summary, the following infrastructure would be installed by the organisers: pre-erected participant tents, toilets, showers, dining marquee, catering, and bar for approximately 1,1k participants. Once finalised, the hiking routes will be shared for feedback. According to the DofE website for this event (https://www.dofe.org/adventure/) there will be live entertainment in the marquee as

well as campfires and cooking areas. The event organisers, www.wearemassive.co.uk have asked FPC for its support for this event, which is now in its third year. The 2018 event was held in the Cotswolds.

2.6 Finally, I would like to introduce photo ID badges with lanyards for all Councillors in the near future in liaison with Arun District Council regarding their production and seek councillors agreement on this approach.

Title of Report Update on Open Spaces
Purpose of Report To note/discuss/ratify

1. Updates for noting

- 1.1 Open Spaces Projects. There are a number of projects in hand such as the re-siting of the North End bus shelter and another Operation Watershed scheme and I will be reporting further in due course. Steps to eradicate moles from North Green are continuing. Fallen tree branches have been removed from three locations along the A24 footpaths in the Wyevale area and a number of flytips have been reported to Arun District Council (ADC) and removed. Work to repair guttering on the Preschool building has been completed. A new street sign "High Barn" is to be installed by ADC. A tree fell very recently in Cross Lane. Its removal was a major task and West Sussex County Council (WSCC) were called in and carried out the required work very promptly.
- 1.2 <u>Findon Village Volunteers.</u> The Team continues to be very active in the Village and a number of tasks have recently been successfully completed including the re-surfacing of the footpath leading north from Soldiers Field Lane. The bulk of the materials (mot and chippings) were donated by the owners of one of the properties fronting the footpath. Findon Parish Council (FPC) is very grateful to them. A lot of cutting back has been done to clear the embankment on the south side of School Hill.

The footpath extending eastwards from The Oval towards the concrete road which leads to Gallops Farm has been cleared as has the footpath adjoining High Street opposite Averys and also part of Cross Lane and its service road north of Steep Lane.

The Team has undertaken the spreading of bark on the footways within the grounds of St John the Baptist School and has also cleared the access leading to the Preschool.

The Team numbers are on the increase and we had a record turnout of 10 at the beginning of April. As a reward for the Team's hard work they were given a day off on 24th April!

2. Issues for consideration/ratification by full Council

2.1 There is an area within the eastern part of the FPC Allotment Gardens which, unlike the rest of them, is in shadow for much of the day owing to an excessive amount of tree cover which seriously hinders the growing of vegetables , fruit etc for a number of plots. The Team is currently undertaking a fairly major job involving some tree felling (the consent of ADC having been obtained) and the tidying up within that area. There are however some large branches which need to be felled by professionals and an estimate of £180 plus VAT has been obtained for that work from AC Gardens. FPC sanction is sought for this work to complete what will be a great improvement.
